Tips & Rules on Collecting Donations:

- When you register online, you can set up your own online fundraising page where pledges can be made via credit card in a safe environment.
- Mention your efforts everywhere you go and to everyone you talk to – you'll be surprised by how many people will be happy to support you!
- Donations can be made by check or online using a credit card at www.komenlacounty.org.
- All donations can either be collected and turned in by the team captain, or team members can submit them in person on Race Day at the donation table at the registration booth or, after 10am, at the donation table at Komen Place.
- Each team member must keep track of his or her own donations.
- Pledges are collected on behalf of and credited to individuals only. If a team receives a general donation, one member must be selected to receive credit for the amount, or the money will be credited to the Team Captain. A post-event tally will be done to determine which team raised the most pledge dollars.
